Note 91

Robe dense, lumineuse. Nez fruité net, d'intensité moyenne. La bouche affiche une agréable harmonie mais est aussi sur la réserve. Un margaux construit pour durer, qui semble s'être refermé depuis la mise en bouteille. Une valeur sûre tout de même

This has a plush feel overall, packed with flavors of cocoa, espresso, bay leaf, roasted mesquite, plum sauce and black currant preserves. The slightly dusty structure is well-embedded in the fruit, offering a tug of earth at the very end and leaving a mouthwatering impression. Best from 2014 through 2025. -JM

*Andreas Larsson* : Very dark and clear colour ; the nose is displaying dark berries, blackcurrant, fine oak and mineral ; the palate is pure and fresh with vibrant dark fruit, excellent freshness, tannin, length and balance - slightly young, but highly potent. Score 91

*Markus del Monego* : Dark, purple red with violet hue. Very elegant nose with a hint of smokiness, ripe berries and a hint of mild spices. Elegant character with good length on the palate. A wine with potential. Score 91

Score 90

Tasted at the UGC tasting in London. I enjoyed this Siran from barrel and it does not disappoint here. It has plenty of black fruit on the nose laced with tobacco, dried violets and plum jam. The palate is medium-bodied with a sweet, almost viscous entry. I feel that there is too much oak dominating the finish - which is a real shame as it is totally unnecessary. I wanted to love this Margaux more than I can, but it is still a commendable Siran. Tasted November 2012.

There's a beautiful core of fruit in this wine with dark chocolate, currant and berry character. Full and velvety, with fresh acidity and a clean finish. All there.

Note 16-17 Grande Réussite

Après un millésime 2009 touché par la grêle, le château a pu, en 2010, exprimer pleinement sa volonté de progression. De fait, le vin s'affirme mieux, plus précis et raffiné. Avec une proportion importante de petit verdot (16%), ce 2010 se montre plein en milieu de bouche et bien tendu en finale. A suivre de près. Excellent rapport qualité/prix.

Couleur sombre. Beau nez fin de fruits noirs. Bouche charnue aux arômes subtils, au corps dense, se développant gracieuse sur une très belle longueur et des tannins fins. Une grande réussite.

Note 93-94

Ce vin s'ouvre sur une superbe trame acide supportée par une matière fruitée (mûres, cassis). Arômes de café noir et de goudron au nez et en bouche. Dense, riche et bien balancé, ce vin est complexe. Probablement l'une de leurs meilleures cuvées à ce jour !

Fine floral aromatics, supple attack, with reassuring tannins on the finish that expand quite a bit leaving the impression of a wine further north... Quite a success at Siran - and for about \$30, an excellent price/quality ratio here. Half and half Cab and Merlot but 11% Petit Verdot in the mix.

Showing nice minerality already, with a stony hint weaving through the supple plum and cassis fruit, followed by a perfumy finish. Should be very suave when finished

Score 90-92

A blend of 42% Merlot, 46% Cabernet Sauvignon and 12% Petit Verdot, the Chateau Siran '10 seems to mark a change in style for this Margaux cru that tended to be overblown in recent years. This is far more composed on the nose with pepper black fruits that remind me of the Loire. It is as if there is some Cabernet Franc in the blend, but this must be emanating from the Petit Verdot. The palate is medium-bodied with a peppery entry, quite rustic in some ways, a little disjointed. They have certainly gone hell for leather with the Petit Verdot and whilst I don't think it quite made a great Margaux, it has individuality and character. I will be intrigued to taste this after bottling. Tasted April 2011.
