The Siran 2011 is a blend of 52% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Petit Verdot and 1% Cabernet Franc picked from 8th until 27th September. Following on from their successful 2010, it has a well defined bouquet with lovely floral notes, fresh strawberries and a touch of cedar. It is very composed. The palate is medium-bodied with tensile tannins on the entry, good acidity, fresh and vibrant with a crisp, fresh finish that bodes well for the future. Siran is back on form. Tasted April 2012.

Deep black cherry, black core. A touch dusty but there's cassis fruit too but also something slightly herbaceous. Direct, fluid, firm but well balanced without the drying tannins of some, though the finish is a bit hard.
