JancisRobinson.com – Jancis Robinson – April 2017

Score 17-

Dark purple. Some excitement and risk on the nose here. Nicely Margaux but pretty intense. Sweet start but enough freshness. Not the most concentrated but nicely judged.

Score 94-95

This is a great follow-up to the 2015! Full-bodied, chewy and powerful. Solid core of ripe fruit and intense tannins. A triumph... again

Score 92-94

"The 2016 Siran is a blend of 46% Cabernet Sauvignon, 44% Merlot, 9% Petit Verdot and 1% Cabernet Franc picked from 26 September until 20 October. The alcohol level is 13.9% with a pH of 3.61. The nose, for want of a better word, is very charming. No, not powerful nor is it flamboyant, yet the aromas are nicely focused and it has a disarming sense of purity: blackberry, bilberry and just a very faint hint of liquorice. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy black fruit, good grip in the mouth and fine purity. This is a strong follow-up to the 2015 Siran and tasting the two side by side, this is one of the very few occasions in the appellation where I think it might surpass it. Edouard Miaillhe has radically improved Siran in recent years (see last year's report) and this is certainly one to watch.

Wine Spectator – James Molesworth – April 2017

Score 89-92

Fresh cherry and bitter plum notes form the core. Shows a pretty backdrop of black tea and a racy-edged structure through the finish.

Wine Enthusiast – Roger Voss – April 2017

Score 95

This is another chateau that's on the rise. This vintage has produced a powerful wine, solid with tannins and concentration. It also has all the fruit that this year has produced. It will age well, being ready to drink in 10 years.

Le Figaro – Frederic Durand-Bazin – Mai 2017

Score 17,5

Petits fruits rouges, cerise griotte, nez profond, dense. Bouche séveuse, juteuse, très longue, sapide, tannins amples, beaucoup de matière.

Revue des Vins de France – Olivier Poels – Avril 2017

Score 16-17

Depuis deux ans, Siran s'est étoffé. Le 2016 est issu des vendanges les plus tardives du château (terminées le 20 octobre). Il s'appuie sur une très belle maturité de cabernets au profil soyeux. Le tout est enrobé et servi par un très bel éclat.

Bettane et Desseauve – Mai 2017

Score 93-94

Beau vin classique de son secteur. On pourrait peut-être faire encore plus grand sur ce splendide terroir.

Decanter – Jane Anson – April 2017

Score 93

A highly attractive vintage for Siran, with a darkly spiced frame coming from a high 9% of Petit Verdot (a grape that did particularly well in 2016), blended with 46% Cabernet Sauvignon, 44% Merlot and 1% Cabernet Franc, with a pH of 3.61. The estate has a new winemaker this year in Marjolaine Defrance. There are clear touches of the florality of Margaux and this is an excellent wine, less succulent than 2015 perhaps, but with intensity, staying power and beautifully poised fruit. This is an estate that just keeps getting better and is a name to follow.
